



MANUFACTURING GENERAL PROGRAMMES

Programmes Available: There are currently two general manufacturing programmes available – and these can be complemented with more general occupational health and safety, quality auditing, HACCP, post-harvest, distribution and business (team leader/manager) qualifications

All the general manufacturing qualifications are designed for most of the training and assessment to take place in the workplace

Learners are typically able to achieve each level of the qualification in a 12-month period

Programmes are: Designed to provide people with foundation skills and knowledge to work in entry level operational, or non-operational roles in the manufacturing sector.

Programme delivery: Typically, these programmes are delivered and assessed by a combination of classroom and on job

For the on-job components – Learners must have at least 3 months previous work experience in a general manufacturing environment, before being enrolled, and must be working in the sector for the duration of the programme.

Programme costs: Costs are per person + GST - **\$350** (If ITO subsidy applies). Travel disbursements may apply. Please contact us for costing of corporate groups which will be negotiable depending on numbers
